Charing in the First World War

(pub. 2018) 65pp A4 size, photographs in b &w, illustrations in colour.

This book is a compilation of the 64 illustrated panels from our 2014 CDLHS exhibition commemorating the centenary of the First World War. It shows how the parish of Charing supported the war and how it was affected by it. Each A4 page is based on an exhibition panel, researched and written by CDLHS. Price £10 + £3 p&p for each copy.

A History of Charing: the parish from earliest times to 1900

(pub 2011) A4 size, 126pp, c. 100 maps, drawings and photographs, in colour and b & w.

Many unpublished documents and maps have been used to bring to life regional and local events, and describe the land, people and occupations. Three further chapters cover the history of the church, the archbishops' palace, and the many historic houses remaining in the village and surrounding countryside. Price £12 + £3 p&p for each copy.

Charing – A Pictorial Past

(pub 2005) A4 size, 116pp, c.200 drawings and photographs, in b & w.

The book begins with several pages of 19th-century drawings and watercolours of Charing, followed by numerous photographs dating from the late 19th century to the present day, arranged by topics and explained by informative captions. Topics include farming, occupations, buildings, the parish church, transport, education, leisure and people. Price £10 + £3 p&p for each copy.
