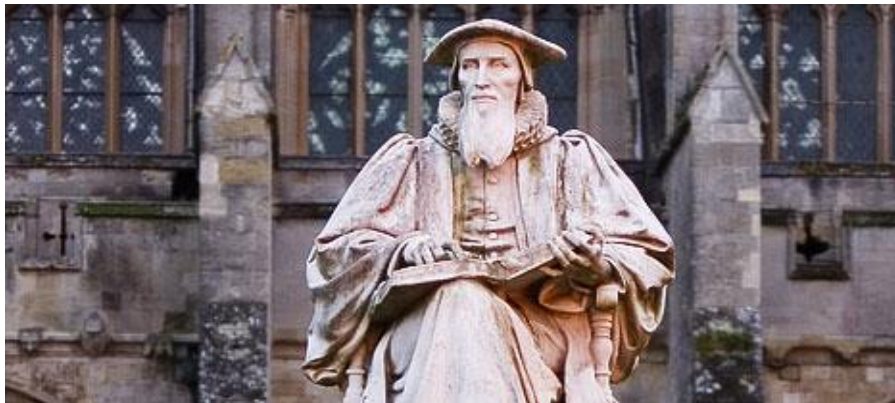


**BRITISH ASSOCIATION FOR LOCAL HISTORY REPORT ON
