For this term there a Music Appreciation course at Wye on the work of Purcell and his contemporaries. This starts on 26/9/18

CANTERBURY - has a Literature course on Jane Austen starting on 17/9/18 and a History course on The Early Tudors: 1485-1558 starting on 26/9/18 and a short course on Garden History starting on 29/9/18.

HERNE BAY – has a Literature course on Virginia Woolf starting on 20/9/18

SWALE – “History: ‘Britain 1870-1914 starting 25/9/18; ‘Art Appreciation; An Historical Overview’ starting 26/09/18 . There is also a Music Appreciation course on Handel starting 24/9/18

TENTERDEN – has 2 Day Schools. There is 1 on Jane Austen on 12/10/18 and one on ‘The Four Romanov Grand Duchesses’ on 16/11/18

TONBRIDGE have ‘History: More Historical Journeys Through England’ which starts on 25/09/18.; There are also 2 Day Schools. One on 13/10/18 on ‘How the United States came into Being’ and one on 30/10/18 on ‘Current International Affairs.’

TUNBRIDGE WELLS- has a group of 4 Day schools the first 3 of which are this term on 27/9/18, 20/10/18 and 17/11/18. These are ‘What Ifs in History’ ‘Law – Death to all Traitors’ and ‘The Arts and Crafts Movement’ There is also a separate day School on 22/09/18 on ‘Female Campaigners’ and a 10 week course on ‘Women Writers over time’ starting 25/09/18-,

WHITSTABLE has a Literature course: ‘Hateship, Friendship, Courtship, Loveship, Marriage!’ starting 19/9/18 , and an Art course on ‘19th Century French Paintings ’starting 24/09/18

In the London book:-

BROMLEY (Beckenham and West Wickham) have ‘London History walks’ starting 20/09/18

BROMLEY itself has 2 History courses ‘King, Parliament and the Civil War’ starting 19/09/18 and ‘Women and Power’ starting 20/09/18
